The following are collaborative project ideas for the Umatilla National Forest that were discussed on the July 16 Listening Tour or that have been proposed by Umatilla National Forest staff.

Provide collaborative input on:

- The overall Umatilla Forest Plan
- The Kahler project: a 30,000-acre project on the Heppner District containing 99% dry forest types
- Develop 5 years of treatments in dry forest types (160K acres) on the Heppner District
- Identify and collaborate on a moist forest project on the Heppner District
  - La Grande research station role? Lit review?
- Heppner District-wide aspen enhancement project
- Landscape Assessment of the Heppner District.
