Meeting purpose: To organize stakeholder involvement in the development of a *unified all-threats, all-lands approach* to sage grouse conservation in Eastern Oregon. The proposed <u>Oregon Sage Grouse Conservation Partnership</u> (the "SageCon Partnership") will coordinate federal, state and local efforts (current and projected) to address the multiple threats to sage grouse across the Eastern Oregon sagebrush landscape in anticipation of the U.S Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) review of the bird's "Warranted But Precluded" status under the federal Endangered Species Act (ESA) (listing decision and critical habitat proposal due in September 2014).

Overarching Goal: By January 2014, the SageCon Partnership will present USFWS with a *unified all-lands* and all-threats approach to sage grouse conservation in Oregon.
