



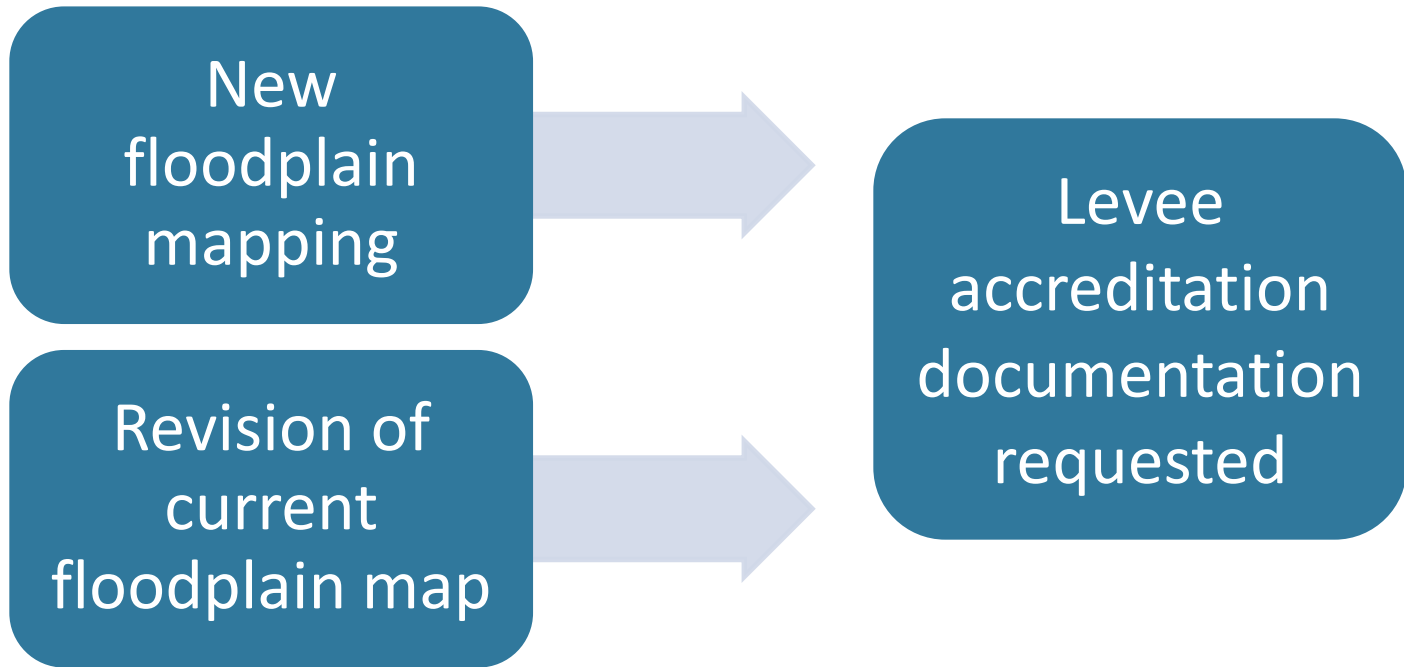

*Current Status of Lower Willamette Basin: Discovery meetings held in 2012; No RISK Map products identified.*

# Levee Accreditation Process & Criteria

*Levees must meet 44 CFR 65.10 to be 'accredited'*

Design Criteria

Operations Plan

Interior Drainage

Maintenance Plan

“Certification”

# Levee Accreditation Process & Criteria

*If a levee cannot be or is not accredited:*

## Levee is de-accredited:

Floodplain is mapped as if levee is not present.

Most land mapped into SFHA.

## Upcoming changes:

Alternative methods for assessing risk behind non-accredited levees (currently in pilot phase).

*Community can submit new information to accredit levees up until ~60 days before map becomes effective.*
