NAYA Generation project has educational and social services components in addition to multigenerational housing.

The site lease agreement is divided into two parts; housing portion (2/3) is under lease, the ELC portion

(1/3) requiring lease agreement to be completed.

City provided funding which allowed PPS to lease site to NAYA for 99 years.

PPS leases the site to NAYA Family Center with the option for NAYA to purchase the site after 15 years.
