Vision for NAYA Generations:

The NAYA Generations project is an innovative integrated multi-generational housing and learning community. Its residents comprise of some of the Native community's most vulnerable elements: Children in foster care/child welfare; elders; and early learners. All aspects of the project from design to programming are culturally –based and guide the delivery of services to residents, learners, and visitors.

The NAYA Generations project generates and nurtures NAYA's core values. The project is intentionally designed sustainable and is LEED platinum certified. The design and construction phase was focused on inclusion and social equity goals for participation by communities who have been historically disenfranchised and failed to benefit from housing resources, educational opportunity and economic opportunity in the development (contracting) phases of the project.

NAYA Generations is a community resource for indigenous-Communities of Color and low income community members in Lents to promote economic opportunity, financial security and healthy lifestyle learning. The project actively promotes cultural awareness, cultural identity and cultural preservation.

The greater Native community and Lents area residents value the project as a vital community asset and resource that enhances the quality of life for all that access housing, learning, health and economic security services and resource information at NAYA Generations.
