CED Overview – What is it?

- Web-based, geospatial components
- Collects information on the plans and projects to conserve greater sage-grouse from 2009 to present
- Conservation plans, individual projects, tabular data from large data sets, spatial data, and documentation of the data sources can all be entered in the CED
- Housed on the data sharing platform, LC Map (aka ScienceBase)

CED Overview

✓ Easy to use

- No GIS skills are required
- USGS programmers are available to help with batch uploads
- User Guide and Help Document

✓ Secure

- Agencies/organizations establish gatekeepers
- Designated “approving officials” will allow for quality control and oversight by agency partners

✓ Transparent

- Information on the CED will become part of the public record and subject FOIA
- Viewable map of approved projects

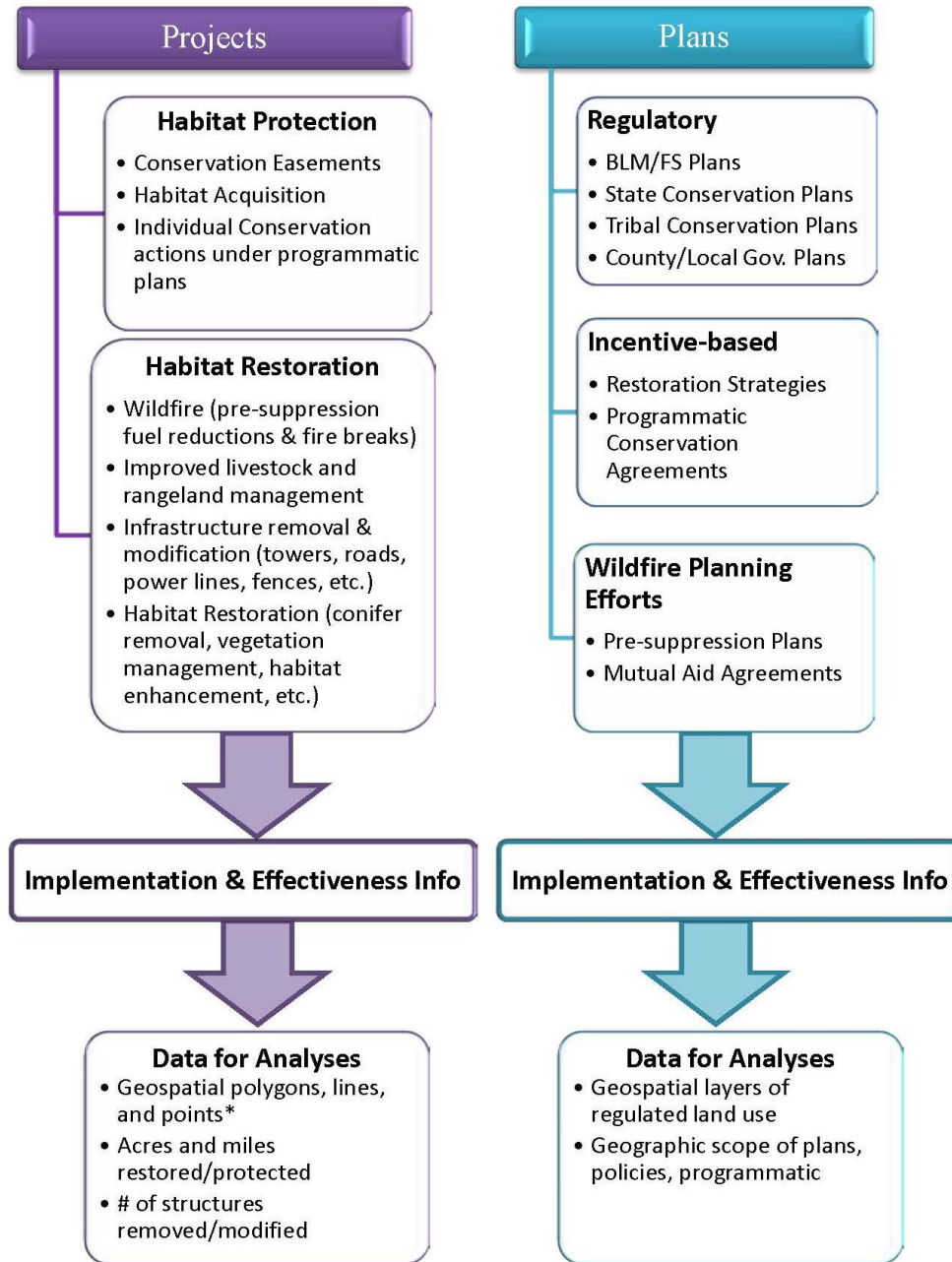

CED Registration Process

- Pre-Registration for Agency Control

Participating Agencies/Organization determine

- What info they want to provide
- How they want to provide it – Batch Upload or Individual Project Entry
- Who will provide the info
- Who will run QA/QC on the info
- Who can modify CED records

- Registration

- User name, Password, generate link to activate account
- Select Agency, Field Office, Approving Official

CED Registration Process

Welcome

All fields with an * are required!

Users must complete the profile, click 'EMAIL APPROVING OFFICIAL', and be approved before data entry can begin.

Hover over field labels to display tool tips when available (Approving Official and Date Approved currently).

NOTE: Individuals working for agencies or organizations that have not yet provided their list of approving officials will be allowed demonstration access only. Please select your agency to determine if your agency has supplied offices and approving officials for our records.

If agency offices exist within the CED but no approving officials exist users will automatically default to Kathy Hollar as their approving official.

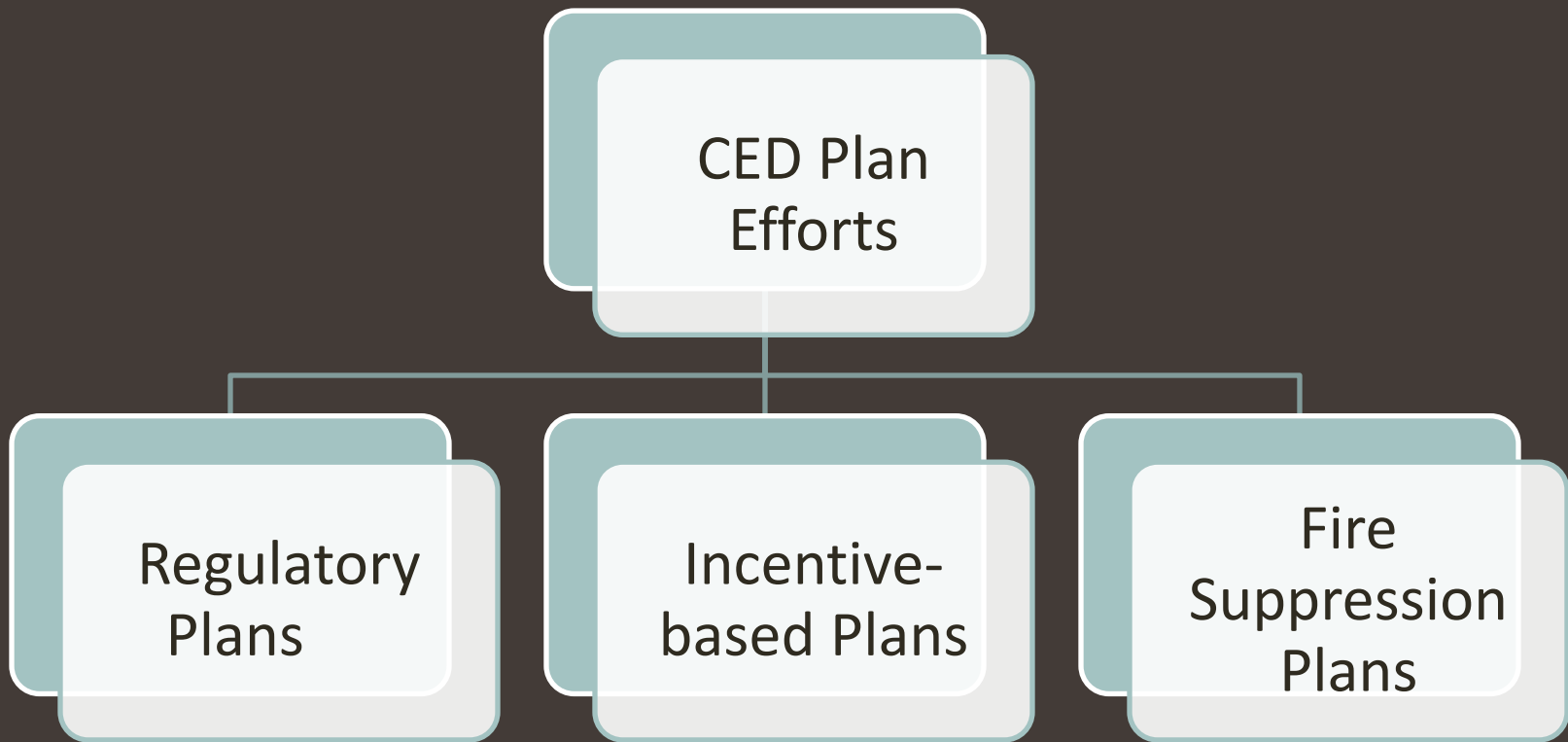

Request: Threat-specific records for each threat addressed in conservation plans

- How the does the plan addresses the suggested COT Report Conservation Objectives
- Policies/regulations/ordinances to prevent/minimize/ameliorate the threat
- Funding source(s) and funding plan
- Obstacles to full implementation of the plan
- Successes in implementing the plan to date
- Implementation plan for the next five years
- Effectiveness monitoring Plans
- Upload relevant documents
