

FFAC-IWG: 6/3 Work Session Action Items and Discussion Summary

Action Items from the work session include:

- Technical assistance and science support implementation – first task orders with the selected service delivery team to be issued in July. (ODF, collaboratives)
- Forest Collaborative grants:
 - OWEB Forest Collaborative Capacity - grant applications due Friday, 6/20.
 - NFF Collaborative Capacity and Land Stewardship - grant applications due 7/10.
- New business model: Planning Efficiencies
 - Set up discussions with the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO), state’s cultural cluster group to consider a new approach to Forest-level ethnographic reports. (ODF, GNRO).
 - Monitor integration of ODF/USFS marking and survey crews to assess efficiencies and results related to advancing dates for getting USFS projects contracted. (ODF, USFS).
- Draft *Socioeconomic Monitoring Plan for the US Forest Service’s Eastside Restoration* Send feedback to Cass Moseley (University of Oregon Ecosystem Workforce Program).
- Federal forest program: 2015-17 approach and related budget development framework. (GNRO, ODF).
- FFAC-IWG: update purpose and vision, proposed name change. Submit comments and suggestions for the revised Purpose and Vision Statement and suggestions on change of name for the FFAC-IWG. (Current recommendation is “*Federal Forest Working Group*” (FFWG)) to Pete Dalke (Oregon Solutions).
- Next work session: Tuesday, July 22 at the State Capitol. Major agenda items: collaborative capacity, barriers and needs. 2015-17 program budget development.*
