### Commission Process Goals:

- Negotiate agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to allow transfer of the Locks to a willing public or private recipient (or in the alternative allow Corps to permanently close the Locks with a concrete bulkhead);
- Develop agreement on a transferee and governance model for owning and operating the Locks; and
- Develop agreement on a fiscal structure and funding to allow for (1) repair and restoration, and (2) ongoing maintenance and operation of the Locks.

- Present comparative information on options and scenarios for financing long-term operations and maintenance (O&M) for the Locks; and
