I have reviewed the Oregon Solutions assessment of the Tillamook Basin Flooding Reduction Project. The assessment report shows a broad level of citizen support for a collaborative approach to reduce future impacts from flooding in the Tillamook basin. By this letter I am designating this project as an Oregon Solutions project and appoint the two of you as co-conveners of this project.

The flooding issues in Tillamook County require a collaborative effort to focus energy and to leverage resources. Oregon Solutions can help to further develop federal, state and local government partnerships with the civic sector to accomplish projects on the ground. The assessment outlined a variety of potential projects to create consensus around flood reduction, including dredging, earth moving and other projects to mitigate flooding while considering habitat implications. While the assessment notes that there will be significant challenges, it also underscores the importance of moving forward and addressing this serious problem for the benefit of the entire community.
