This matter coming before the Board of County Commissioners at this time and it appearing that there is a continuing need for additional and more equitable funding for law enforcement services in Clackamas County; and

It further appearing there has been public involvement and support for establishing a service district for enhanced law enforcement services in the unincorporated urban area; and

It further appearing that the establishment of a County service district pursuant to ORS Chapter 451 is the most feasible method of providing enhanced law enforcement services; and

It further appearing that a master plan and economic feasibility study for such a district has been prepared; and

It further appearing that the creation of such a service district constitutes a major boundary change subject to the jurisdiction of the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the formation of the "Clackamas County Enhanced Law Enforcement District", with boundaries as shown on the attached Exhibit 1, is initiated, and that a certified copy of this Order, plus appropriate supporting materials be submitted to the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission.

This matter coming before the Board of County Commissioners at this time and it appearing that there is a continuing need for additional and more equitable funding for law enforcement services in Clackamas County and that establishment of a County service district pursuant to ORS Chapter 451 is the best method of providing such funding and services; and

It further appearing that this Board, by its Order No. 94-671, dated June 23, 1994, initiated formation of a service district for enhanced law enforcement services; and

It further appearing that the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission considered the proposal for such a district on July 28, 1994, and has entered its final Order, Boundary Change Proposal No. 3354, approving the proposed formation; and

It further appearing that the County has complied with the requirements of ORS 310.180-.188;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an election shall be held on November 8, 1994, to determine whether to establish and fund with a \$3,354,427 tax base the "Clackamas County Enhanced Law Enforcement District", with boundaries as stated in the attached Exhibit "A" and shown on the attached Exhibit "B"; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attached Exhibit "C", "Notice of Tax Levy Measure Election" and Exhibit "D", "Explanatory Statement for County Voters' Pamphlet" be filed with the County Clerk and be included in the County Voters' Pamphlet; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a map showing the district boundaries be included with the election ballots in accordance with ORS 198.815(3); and
